INFORMATION ON THE PROCESSING OF PERSONAL DATA IN THE POLISH-LUXEMBOURG CHAMBER OF COMMERCE (PLIG)

1. The Administrator of personal data is the Polish-Luxembourg Chamber of Commerce with headquarters in Wrocław, ul. Rzeźnicza 32-33, II p., 50-130 Wrocław, hereinafter referred to as "Administrator".
2. In any matters related to the processing of personal data, please contact the Administrator at the email address: rodo@plig.biz.
3. Personal data will be processed in order to:
 - a. inform about the planned events, conferences, publications, send out the newsletter and other marketing activities carried out on the basis of the voluntarily consent;
 - b. take up activities leading to consider the membership application and to execute membership in the PLIG;
 - c. the Administrator's implementation of obligations arising from legal provisions;
 - d. the implementation of legitimate interests pursued by the Administrator, including the investigation of any claims.
4. The recipient of personal data may be the Administrator's service providers, member companies, entities associated with the Administrator.
5. Personal data will be processed during the period of your membership in the PLIG, and after its termination for a period resulting by legal provisions or until your consent is withdrawn.
6. You have the right to request: access to your personal data, rectification, deletion, limit data processing, data transfer and the right to object.
7. Consent to the processing of personal data can be withdrawn at any time. Withdrawal of consent does not affect the lawfulness of processing based on this consent before its withdrawal.
8. You have the right to lodge a complaint with the supervisory authority competent for the protection of personal data.
9. Providing personal data is voluntary, but the failure to provide the data will result in the inability to become a member of PLIG.
